Proposal Abstract Outline (Adapted from Proposal Outline by John S. Harris, BYU)

- I. First sentence: succinct statement of problem and what you propose to build
- II. Past Attempts at Solution
 - A. Existing solutions to problem
 - B. Shortcomings of existing solutions
- III. Proposed Solution
 - A. Method and procedure of proposed solution
 - B. Expected results (performance specs of final system)
- IV. Substantiation
 - A. Time Line (summarize time line in words)
 - B. Budget (summarize budget in words)
- V. Gantt Chart (attach as separate page)
 - A. Define tasks in terms of precisely-defined deliverables
 - B. Gantt Chart with bars showing beginning and ending time of tasks
- VI. Budget (attached as separate page)
 - A. List each significant cost item as a line in budget
 - B. Use following column headings: item #, qty, part #, description, amnt, ext
