



Assignment 6: Project Background section, Sr Project Proposal

Instructions

Write a <u>two-page</u> background section for your senior project. This section corresponds to the "Past Attempts at Solution" section of the proposal abstract outline, below. The purpose of this section is multifold:

- 1) To motivate the reader to be interested in the problem you are solving
- 2) To persuade the reader that there is a need for a solution to the problem you are solving
- 3) To educate the reader about the problem you are solving
- 4) To alert the reader to the shortcomings of existing solutions for the problem you are solving
- 5) To convince the reader that you have a thorough knowledge of the state of the art for the problem you are solving
- 6) To present the reader with citations (i.e., references) that contain more information about the problem you are solving

Pay particular attention to delineating the specific shortcomings of existing solutions for the problem you are solving, as your project description must specifically address each shortcoming.

Use the IEEE Conference Paper Format for your background section, but use only a single column rather than two.
